



It is our pleasure to announce that this past weekend Clayton Brown, XstremeMD Operations Manager, has taken and passed the Associate Safety Professionals (ASP) exam on his first attempt. The ASP (often called CSP Safety Fundamentals exam) is the first test required in the two-test process of becoming a Certified Safety Professional (CSP). The five hour computer delivered test consists of 200 questions designed to measure the academic knowledge expected of a safety professional.

The ASP exam is administered by the Board of Certified Safety Professionals. BCSP is recognized as a leader in high-quality credentialing for Safety, Health, and Environmental (SH&E) practitioners. BCSP establishes standards for and verifies competency in professional safety practice and evaluates individuals for compliance with recertification requirements.
